# Assistant minister (part-time) 'Community Pastor'

## About St Michael's:

St Michael's Anglican Cathedral has a vision to see more disciples of Jesus, shining as lights, in our city. We're an Anglican church – Reformed & Evangelical in conviction. Under God, we hope to impact this area powerfully: that more would come to follow Him, and all would be blessed by our presence in both the heart of Wollongong's CBD and in the northern suburbs around Corrimal.

We currently have 6 congregations over 2 sites. St Michael's is currently looking for a new member of our staff team. The 'Community pastor' is an outward-facing role: engaging those not yet in church and overseeing St Michael's 'Engage & Evangelise' ministries. We're looking for a woman or man with a heart for the lost like Christ's.

## Focus of the role includes:

- Oversight of 2 key areas of the church's strategy (through key lay leaders):
  - Evangelise the lost with gospel of Jesus
  - Engage the community with sacrificial love
- Participating in prayer and planning meetings with the staff.
- Participate in general ministry, championing those not yet in church.
- Involvement in one regular congregation and rotation across others.
- Evangelising local unbelievers in the area (area includes the broader city – prioritising the parish bounds of Wollongong and Corrimal). Creating new contacts, as well as engaging those who connect with current structures.
- Helping St Michael's be a known, positive presence in the local community.
- Build a culture of Evangelism and Church planting.
- Equipping members to be confident gospel speakers in their general life.
- Oversee initiatives that express 'engaging the community with sacrificial love' (social action/mercy ministry).
- Actively involved in discipling 'new believers' – establishing them in congregational life.
- Meet with individuals who are either: 1) Not yet Christian; 2) Keen and convicted gospel speakers.

## Essential criteria:

Specific details of the role could vary, according to the gifts & passions of the person in the role. The essentials are:

- Conviction: Reformed, Evangelical Christian – with a deep, living faith in Jesus as personal Saviour and Lord
- Character: An exemplary and growing Christian character that imitates and models Christ
- Competency:
  - gifted and passionate in disciple-making;
  - teaching ability and experience in cross-cultural ministry;
  - capacity to lead teams, equip & recruit leadership
- Qualifications:
  - Recognised theological training or willingness to appropriately train as you work.

The role is part-time (0.6 FTE), remuneration in accord with Sydney Diocese guidelines. Applications close December 22<sup>nd</sup> or if the role is filled earlier.
